

# Vocabulary Study Packet

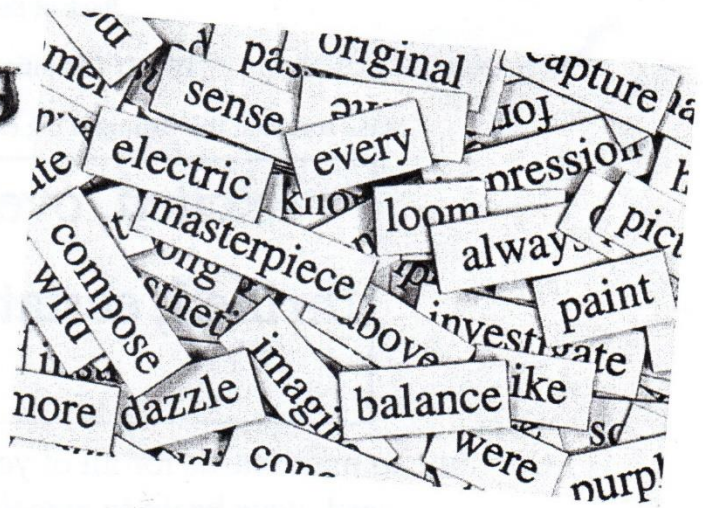

Make sure the word is spelled correctly!!


Picture or memory clue

In the SAME COLOR AS THE FRONT Definition/meaning of the word and any synonyms

Make sure that the writing is big enough to see quickly and clearly

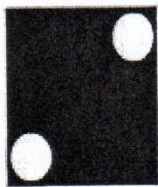

Continue to make cards for all of your words. Only use one color per card, your brain to associate the color and word.

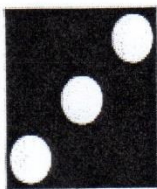
